**Objective:** To graduate in the shortest time possible; designed to be completed in 3 years and 1 semester

- In the 3rd Year, students will take Fiqh of Hadith I & II, which contains textual analysis of the 40 hadith. They will thus be prepared to understand the ahadith in Arabic. Their knowledge of Arabic will also be beneficial in memorizing and understanding the text.
